2023 IN REVIEW

This year, we renewed three contracts, enhancing them significantly (one for financial services and two for libraries), and we introduced a completely new contract for **Managed Solutions (S05)**, including health care.

We doubled the number of suppliers on our **Financing & Leasing Contract (F19)** to include six options for schools, towns, and other not-for-profit organizations to manage their finances and invest in their futures. Whether you're looking to update your technology, begin new construction, or need to enhance your fleet of vehicles, this contract has options for you.

To improve how our contracts serve New England libraries, we've been hard at work retooling our offerings. Our former con-

tract handling library subscription management services (L52) has been merged into a more robust **Library Books & Media contract (L51)**, now with six new suppliers. Similarly, our **Library Equipment, Software & Service contract (L53)** has been augmented with four new suppliers our members have been requesting.

Finally, in response to member need, we launched an entirely new **Managed Solutions contract (S05)**. Currently, this includes two suppliers—one that offers consulting for tackling business-related issues, and another that provides clinician-supported crisis care.

Whatever your field, we know you'll find solutions to support your needs and help your organization grow in the new year.

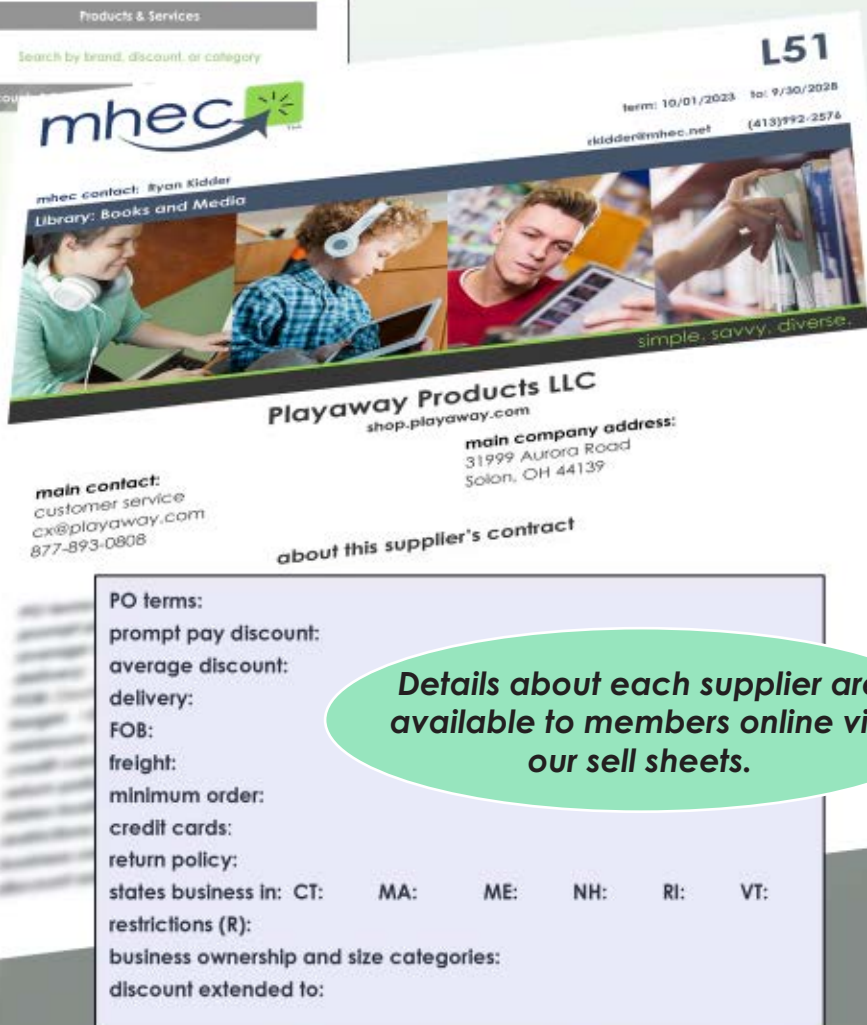

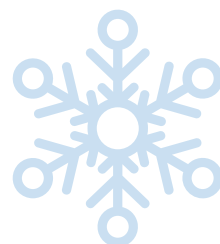

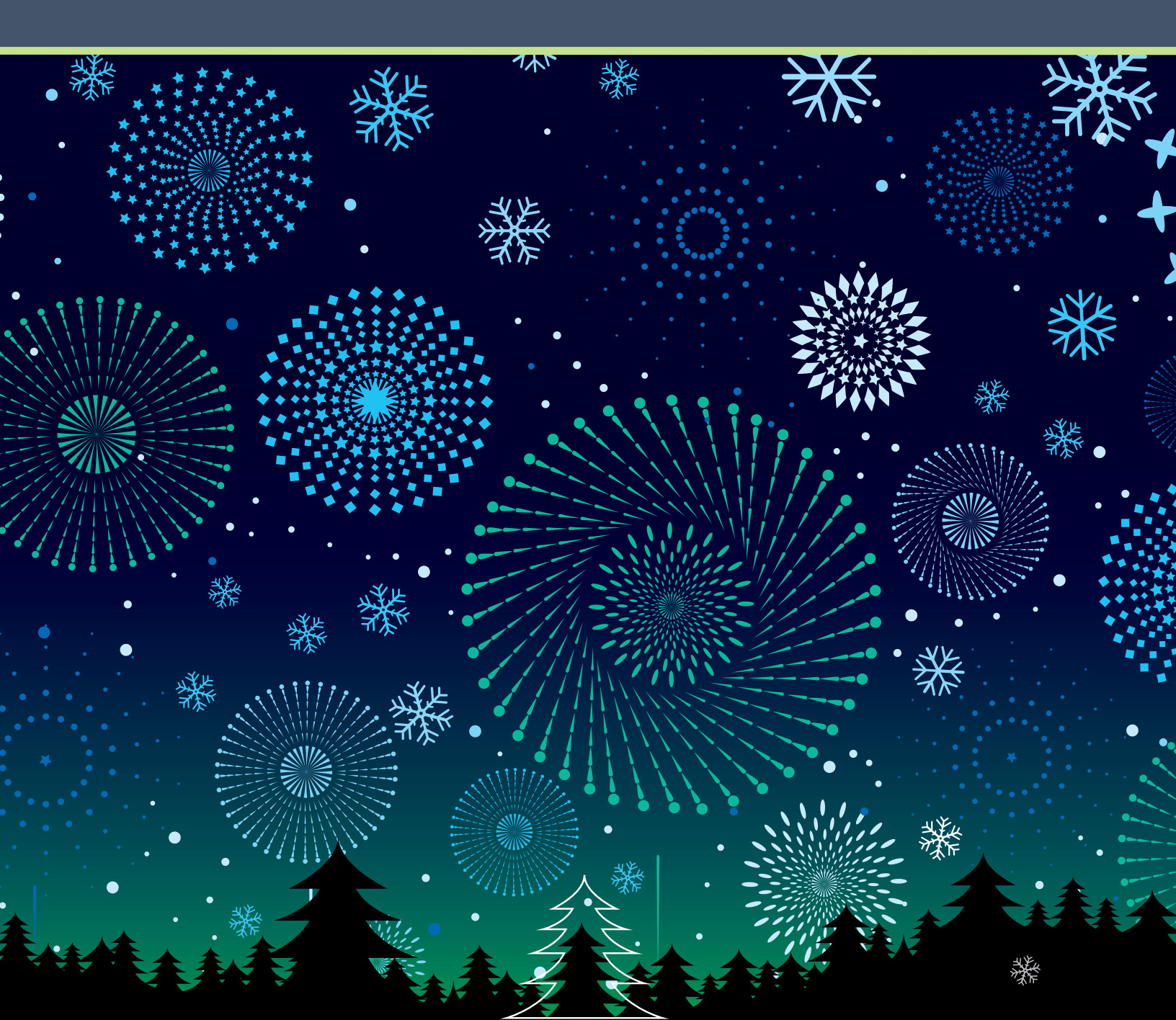
