England not-for-profit organizations totaling more than \$11,000.

Home Depot is represented on MHEC's Maintenance, Repair, and Operations (MRO) contract (G19), and we have an exclusive promotion for our members. By registering your organization with Home Depot, all purchases made in-store and online will go toward earning 3% back when spend is equal to or exceeds \$3,000.

Because these universities, colleges, schools, and towns signed up for this pro-

gram and shopped at Home Depot, one institution received a check for nearly \$1,800.

In addition to the refund, the program offers members 20% off of paint purchases, volume discounts, bulk pric-

US BEDDING ON CONTRACT

As of July 1, MHEC welcomes US Bedding back on our contract for mattresses and hospitality products (C05). This mattress manufacturer has a client list that includes colleges, nursing homes, hotels, and furniture retail stores.

The minority-owned business is based in Fall River, Massachusetts, but serves all of New England. Known for their commitment to personalized service, they work with customers from quote through fabrication to



delivery. US Bedding even has their own fleet of delivery trucks and can provide installation and removal of their product.

Owner, David Nguyen, fled Vietnam in 1979 and fell in love with Fall River for its historic mill district. Since 2006, his business was based in one such mill building until exponential growth forced him to look to expand. The success of his business attracted many suitors, hoping he'd leave the state, including the governor of South Carolina.

"They have a lower tax rate and cheaper materials," Nguyen said of the southern state, but his dedication to Fall River and the New England region kept the business' roots local. In 2021, US Bedding's staff of 36 relocated across town to a vacant Sam's Club. They are now 66 employees strong and well on their way from producing 300 mattresses a day to 1,000.

As reported in his local newspaper, The Herald News, Nguyen is excited by his new investment in space and staff. "I think I can do a good thing for the community here, and that's the bottom line," he said.

Regularly updated and enhanced, MHEC contracts are more versatile and current than

those used by purchasing consortiums that work with boilerplate terms.

In the following pages, we offer a complete list of our more than 50 contracts, along with detailed descriptions of what they contain. Not finding what you're looking for? Our team of strategic sourcing managers stands by, ready to help.

SEARCH TOOL & LANDING PAGES

With more than 50 contracts available to members from towns, universities, and libraries across New England, finding the item or service you're looking for can be daunting. That's why MHEC offers multiple tools to help our members locate the supplier, product, or service they're looking for.

Each contract has its own unique title and identifying code (such as F05 for our Technology contract). Knowing these numbers can make your search easier, but they're not essential.

Our **contract landing page** menu organizes the contracts into sixteen basic categories, such as "athletics & recreation," "communications," and "office & school." Dragging your cursor over the icons for these categories will reveal the list of contracts



included. Selecting any one of these will result in a landing page that provides a comprehensive overview of all the suppliers included on a given contract. Here, you can find pricing,

whether a supplier is diverse, and if they're represented on i-buy, our online purchasing tool. Each supplier has a **sell sheet** with terms and contact information for that business.

Alternately, our longtime members often turn to our **Search Tool**. Here, you can define and refine search criteria with a collection of four drop-downs (contract, vendor, brand, category). A "Filter Results" option allows you to sift further through the data until you find the supplier or item you're looking for. Additionally, there is a keyword search feature that will scan the text of all the contracts for a match.

As our contracts are regularly being updated and expanded, we're always looking for ways to improve how we present all we have to offer. Recent changes to our website's navigation should help, and the following overview of our portfolio is the most complete to date. 
