

CONTRACT IMPROVEMENTS PLANNED

Big improvements and greater savings are in the works for one of MHEC's most popular and well-used contracts.

MHEC's team of strategic sourcing managers work full-time to keep our portfolio of 50+ contracts serving our members optimally. This includes quarterly reviews, and when a contract's term ends, it can be re-



newed as is, or reopened to enhance our selection of suppliers.

Though still months away, our popular contract for all things building maintenance (G19: Facilities: Maintenance, Repair & Operations) will be re-bid this spring. Given its success, favorite suppliers will likely continue, but we've been looking into ways to make the contract even more valuable to our members.

Collaborating with the Universities of Massachusetts, New Hampshire, and Maine, MHEC is working with these members to help them with their MRO needs. As part of this process, MHEC is creating a marketbasket for items commonly needed in building maintenace and upkeep. Leveraging the buying power of these state institutions in order to offer our members the lowest prices available, this marketplace will be available to ALL our members.

These changes will not take effect until sometime this summer, and we will announce details as they become available.
